**Tulsa Run Issues Statement Regarding Course Re-route and Timing Impacts**

**Due to unexpected and severe rainfall** early this morning, **Tulsa Run organizers** made the difficult but necessary decision to re-route sections of the racecourse to ensure the safety of all runners, volunteers, and spectators. **The rapidly changing weather conditions** created unsafe areas along the original route, requiring immediate adjustments to protect participants.

**We understand** that these changes caused confusion during the event and significantly affected race times for many runners. We deeply regret the disruption this caused and sincerely apologize to all participants whose race experience was impacted. Safety will always remain our top priority, but we recognize the importance of clear communication and consistency in event management.

**Tulsa Run officials** are currently working with our timing and course management partners to review and verify race data. **We are committed** to providing accurate information and updates to all affected participants as soon as possible. In addition, a full review of our emergency procedures and communication protocols will be conducted to strengthen our response plans for future events.

**We greatly appreciate** the understanding, patience, and continued support of our runners, volunteers, and the Tulsa community. Your dedication makes this event possible year after year, and we remain committed to maintaining the trust you place in us.
